Aiming for Silver

This year at Milngavie Primary we aim to achieve our Rights Respecting Schools Silver Award: Rights Aware.

We have recently achieved Bronze Award: Rights Committed status.

The Right Respecting Schools Award recognises achievement in putting the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (CRC) at the heart of a school's planning, policies, practice and ethos.

Learning About Rights

There are three strands to achieving the RRS award. This month we will start off with a focus on

strand A: Teaching and learning about rights

This month we will refamiliarise ourselves with the articles and use these to create our Class Charters for the session. Class Charters help to establish and build shared values and relationships for creating a rights respecting ethos within each classroom.



Article of the Month

Each month we will learn about a new UNCRC article. This month we will be focussing on Article 42 - Everyone should know about the UNCRC. We have chosen this as our first right as we aim to dedicate a great deal of time this year to raise awareness about children's rights.
