## Article of the Month

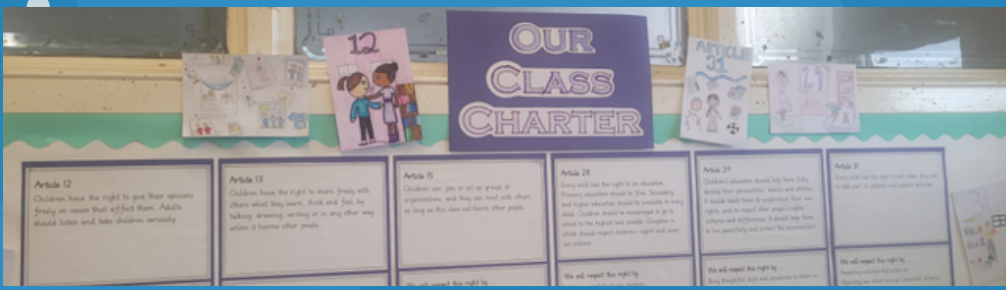
This month is Black History Month so we will have a focus on Article 2 - Every child has rights "without discrimination of any kind, irrespective of the child's or his or her parent's or legal guardian's race, colour, sex, language, religion, political or other opinion, national, ethnic or social origin, property, disability, birth or other status"

## Black History Month

Black History Month takes place in October every year and is a celebration of key figures and events in Black history.

Having begun in the USA, it has been celebrated in the UK since 1987, with the emphasis on celebrating particularly the history and contributions to society of people with an African or Caribbean heritage.





## Rights Across the School

This term each class has looked closely at the UNCRC and used these to create their own Class Charter. This charter is a visual document that establishes an agreed set of rights-based principles upon which relationships can be based and which provide a language for shared values. Creating these charters helps support a positive learning environment for children in the classroom

P2 and P5 have also been looking closely at the UNCRC from discussing needs and wants to exploring the reasons why not all children get to access their right to education.
