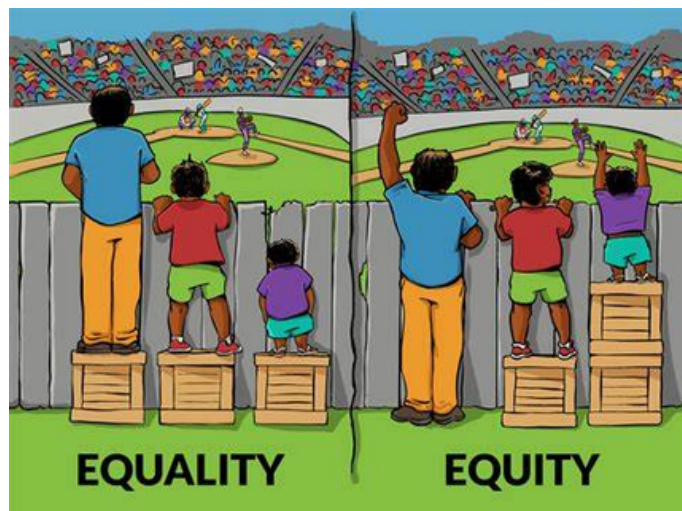

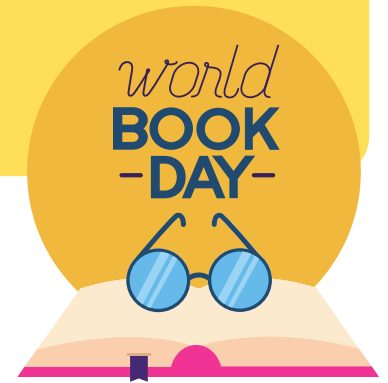
Duty Bearer of the Month
